<b>Course objectives:</b> Acquiring the necessary verbal and non-verbal knowledge and skills in the field of communication and related sciences applied in the field of physical education and sports. Introduction to the process of analysis of phenomena in communication at theoretical and practical level and procedures. Getting to know basic communication skills and rules.			
<b>Course outcome:</b> Indication of differences and similarities between traditional and modern communication approaches in the process of physical education and diverse sports activities. Connecting to related disciplines. Training students for independent approach in solving problems in this field. Each student will be able to independently apply communication skills in relation to defining, analyzing and diagnosing the status of the level of development of a sports organization, sports efficiency of athletes and teams. Total communication skills will serve to solve the diverse problems of group and interpersonal communication.			
<b>Contents description</b> Basic communication concepts (information, communication stimulus, message, interaction and transaction, communication circuits, transactional games, communication systems and meta-systems). Basic communication rules (flexibility, skills, respect for context, respect for others, self-esteem, team work ...). Verbal and non-verbal communication. Meta-linguistic communication. Non-verbal dimensions. Body language and sport. Types of communication. Media and mass communication. Group communication. Interpersonal communication. Rumor communication. Communication and mass culture. Audience. Communication and manipulation. Censorship and communication.
