**Couse objectives:** Leading the master study students towards their first scientific papers in English language (textbook in combination with authentic, texts, tailored to experience and interests of the students.

## **Course description**

Theoretical instruction

Students are introduced with the initial phases of the academic writing process starting with topic selection, review of the sources, their integration in one's own paper, followed by the rhetorical features of different paragraph types and obligatory elements of persuasive writing. Introduction to the characteristics of academic writing genre in English language.

Practical classes: exercises

In collaboration with the core course teachers, students can prepare a research plan and an abstract for their study research paper in English language.
