<b>Course objectives</b> to develop theoretical basis and skills related to the teaching methods of physical education needed for internship in schools and as a foundation for successful mastering of this subject at the fourth year of the studies.				
<b>Course description</b>				
This course will contribute to the students' development of the theoretical basis in PE teaching and thus prepare students for introduction of more complex theoretical and skill knowledge through the subject "Teaching methods of physical education 2" (fourth year of the studies).The students will acquire basic knowledge, teaching skills and experiences of PE instruction in junior primary school. Students will be prepared for pedagogical practice in the seventh and eighth semesters.				
<b>Course :</b>				
<i>Theory teaching</i>				
Theory teaching provides knowledge about the system of physical education (basic elements of the theory and methods of physical education), knowledge about physical education as a professional activity and academic discipline. The contents of the course include important theoretical bases and teaching methods of physical education necessary for application in primary school settings in physical education.				
<i>Practical classes:</i>				
Practical classes include presentations in schools, practical work of students in the form of pedagogical practice, and seminar exercises for students. The teaching practice component of this course provides for the acquisition of teaching skills and professional competencies in applied junior primary school settings in physical education.
