Course objectives: students should gain knowledge about football and understand basic principles of the game and become qualified for organizing and realization of teaching content in football in primary and high schools. They should become qualified for organizing and realization of teaching content in football within regular and extracurricular activities (football sections and competitions), as well as in different recreational and basic football programs.			
Course outcome: Each student has gained basic knowledge in football. He or she understands principles of the game and is capable of demonstrating elementary football skills and tactical maneuvers; he or she is capable of independently applying football as a tool of teaching in physical education in primary and high schools. It is expected that he or she is capable of organizing and realization of football lessons within extracurricular activities – training and competitions within football sections, as well as organizing recreational activities using football as a tool. Best students are qualified to work independently with football beginners in the co-called “football academies”, as well as with other age range of football players.			
Contents description: <i>Theoretical instruction</i> History of football, rules of the game, selection in football, football technique, football tactic, basic of energetic – motor preparation, basic planning and programming football training, football as a tool of teaching in physical education. <i>Practical classes:</i> Football technique, football tactic, rule of the game, football as a tool of teaching in physical education.
