Course objectives: The course is aimed at introducing students to professional terminology by applying CLIL (combining authentic, unabridged texts or adapted texts to the experience and needs of the students.			
Course outcome: In order to enable students to continue studies in different language environments, they are trained to use professional literature (reading, oral production, writing of essays, translation, letter writing). The instruction is interactive, student-oriented and the teacher only organize activities. This is aimed at achieving the course objective which includes mastering the skills necessary for successful communication, understanding of professional texts written in English language, enabling thus students to use relevant sources written in English language.			
Course description			
<i>Theoretical instruction</i>			
Introduction to new and review of grammar items is done inductively on ESP texts, with a focus on those that are characteristic for sport-related topics. Intensive improving of presentation skills, writing skills (different forms of written communication and their features), as well as oral production about the read texts. Language activities imply usage of appropriate communication in a specific situation as provided in the units in order to do the required tasks..
