Getting acquainted with sports weapons, ammunition and targets; 2. Introduction with standards of shooting range and equipment; 3. Safe handling of weapons and ammunition; 4. Training of the basic standing position for shooting with a serial air rifle; 5. Training the basic attitude for shooting with the air gun; 6. Lying and kneeling training; 7. Adopting the correct technique of shooting and firing with and without dividing; 8. Use of tools in the technical preparation of shooters; Visit and familiarize with the basic technical standards of the shooting range for small, large caliber and flying targets.
