Course objectives: Sport pedagogy as a socio-humanistic and applied science. Methods and forms of teaching in sport pedagogy. Models of contemporary teaching. In taking this course, students should understand and accept educational discourse as processes that contributes to the development of athletes' personalities; that, in addition to sports, it is equally important to develop the intellectual, moral, and aesthetic aspect of the athlete's personality; that athletes accept education as a value and meet their educational needs in different contexts.			
Course outcome: Identifying the dependence of education and upbringing, the possibilities and limits of their realization through sport in the sport itself; the importance of personal engagement through the processes of self-education and self-nurture; accepting the necessity of self-education and self-learning.			
Contents description: <i>Theoretical instruction:</i> General pedagogical issues; pedagogical issues of contemporary sport; pedagogical problems of the sports group; orientation and selection in contemporary sport; pedagogical aspects of leisure time of athletes; didactic aspects of the coaching profession; preventing and punishing athletes; the authority of trainers and the success of athletes; will as a factor of success in modern sports. <i>Practical instruction:</i> Work in smaller groups, development of research instruments, application of them on students, statistical processing of obtained data, interpretation of research results, making conclusions with proposals for measures to improve the state of pedagogical work in sports.
