UNIVERSITY CAREER

While making his player's and coach's career Mr. Jankovic also completed the Faculty of Sports and Physical Education, at the University of Belgrade, and defended his final examination work whose topic was related to the top-class football players training. After he acquired University Degree he began studying at the Advanced School for Coaches, and completed it, with final examination work related to teaching methods in players training. He continued his education at the same Faculty and won the Master's Degree, his dissertation dealing with football tactics in the World Championships in France, and Japan and South Korea. He got the job at the Faculty of Sports and Physical Education, in 2000, and since then he has published, either as an author or co-author, several works dealing with football games issues. Presently he prepares his Doctor's Degree dissertation in the field of sport psychology in contemporary top-level football.

Aleksandar Jankovic defended his doctoral dissertation at the University of Belgrade, Faculty of Sport and Physical Education on November 17th, 2006. The committee members were: professor Veljko Aleksic, PhD (advisor); associate professor Dusanka Lazarevic, PhD; professor Stanimir Joksimovic, PhD (University of Nis). The dissertation was titled "**The influence of some psychological factors on the success of contemporary elite soccer**" and was written in addition to the number of scientific publications based on

tactics issue in soccer (pressing counter attack, development of world soccer, contemporary attack tactics in soccer, similarities and differences in the attack tactics in Meridian Super league and Champions League, etc.). The dissertation itself was based on the psychological issue of the soccer game (intelligence, personality, motivation, anxiety) and was an attempt of the author to make deeper penetration in the problem of contemporary soccer.

Jankovic has been employed at the University of Belgrade, Faculty of Sport and Physical Education since 2000. He is author and co-author of the several textbooks and scientific papers that consider the problems in soccer.

PLAYER'S CAREER

Football club „RAD“ Belgrade

Mr. Aleksandar Jankovic was born in the sport's family, since his father was a state representation player and later a top-level handball coach. While he was their coach the handball club „Radnicki“ from Belgrade won the European championship. Aleksandar started playing football in late 1970s when he was not yet eight years old. Basic knowledge of what became his future vocation he acquired at Football School in Pancevo. He was a midfield player and was recognized for his extraordinary technique, what helps him even today in demonstrations. He played for the following clubs: FC „DINAMO“, FC „RAD“, FC „OBILIĆ“ and FC „PSK“.

COACH'S CAREER

Football club „RAD“ Belgrade

Mr. Jankovic began working as a coach in 1992. He was a coach of youngster categories for four years, and in 1996, he became a coach assistant (first coach) of the FC „RAD“ which competed in the first state league.

Football club „RED STAR“ Belgrade

Three years later, when his club was at the fourth position in the league, as a young coach, he moved to the most successful club in Serbia & Montenegro – FC „RED STAR“. He spent almost two years working with seniors and younger categories. His senior team took part in the UEFA competition and they were displaced by the French team FC „MONPELIE“. With the youngster teams he won several first places at various European championships.

LITEX FC, Lovech – Bulgaria

In 2001 Aleksandar worked as a coach assistant (first team coach) with the multiple champion of Bulgaria, LITEX, Lovech. In that season LITEX won the Bulgarian cup and right to take part in the European competition.

FC „VOJVODINA“, Novi Sad

Presently Mr. Jankovic is coach assistant in several first-league clubs: FC „VOJVODINA“ Novi Sad, FC „ZEMUN“, OFK „BEOGRAD“.

FC „VOJVODINA“ reached the semifinals of the S&M championship, and OFK BEOGRAD is at the fourth position what ensures their participation in the European competitions.

C ZELEZNIK, Beograd, CUP SCG

Jankovic was the coach assistant in SC "Zeleznik" in the session 2004-05. In that session SC "Zeleznik" won Cup SCG beating SC "Red Star" in the final (1:0).

NATIONAL TEAM OF SERBIA, under 21

Since the summer of 2006 Jankovic has been the coach assistant in the National Team of Serbia for the players younger than 21. Led by Miroslav Djukic, Serbian national team was qualified for the European championship that was held in Netherlands in 2007. Serbian national team won the second place at this competition. Following this big success Djukic and Jankovic were promoted as a coaching tandem in "A" National Selection.

"A" NATIONAL TEAM OF SERBIA

Jankovic spent a season as a coach assistant in "A" National Team of Serbia. During this period several non-official matches were played against the most qualitative teams of Germany, Russia, Ireland, Ukraine, etc.

OLIMPIC TEAM OF SERBIA

Jankovic was a coach assistant in Olympic Team of Serbia. During Olympic tournament in Peking in 2008, Serbian team played three official matches against Australia, Ivory Coast and Argentina.
